You need not confront anyone but report any problems of work being done without approval/application, to Management Co. as soon as possible!

SUMMARY OF PERTINENT "GUIDELINES for CONTRACTORS & VENDORS " (Ask contractor to look at these items below!)
1. When a job starts the contractor shall provide the number and names of workers to be allowed on the site. Security personnel will not be able to allow workers on site unless the application has been submitted/accepted and fees paid. (7 days in advance of work.)
2. Workers are to notify security upon arrival and departure each day. Work to be done between hours of 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM
3. Blue grocery-type carts are not to be used. (Residents only.) Fire/security doors near stairwells and elevator doors must not be propped open unless guarded.
4. Waste and refuse may not be put in trash chute or dumpster but must be moved off site daily. Dropped debris, etc. in common areas must be cleaned up immediately.
5. Toxic or noxious fumes must be exhausted properly.
6. Only approved hoses, valves and pipes may be used.
ALL WORKERS (NOT JUST RENOVATIONS) MUST SIGN IN ASKED IF THEY ARE DOING RENOVATION WORK. Report problems to Management Co.
